PROVERBS 12:3 (NKJV)

But the root of the righteous cannot be moved.



PROVERBS 12:12 (NKJV)

<sup>12</sup>The wicked covet the catch of evil men,  
But the root of the righteous yields fruit.

PSALMS 92:13 (NKJV)

<sup>13</sup>Those who are planted in the house of the Lord  
Shall flourish in the courts of our God.



BETTER ROOTS MUST BE:

WATERED



JEREMIAH 17:8 (NKJV)

**<sup>8</sup>For he shall be like a tree planted by the waters,  
Which spreads out its roots by the river,  
And will not fear when heat comes;  
But its leaf will be green,  
And will not be anxious in the year of drought,  
Nor will cease from yielding fruit.**



## PSALMS 1:1-3 (NKJV)

<sup>1</sup>Blessed is the man  
Who walks not in the counsel of the ungodly,  
Nor stands in the path of sinners,  
Nor sits in the seat of the scornful;  
<sup>2</sup>But his delight is in the law of the Lord,  
And in His law he meditates day and night.



## PSALMS 1:1-3 (NKJV)

<sup>3</sup>He shall be like a tree  
Planted by the rivers of water,  
That brings forth its fruit in its season,  
Whose leaf also shall not wither;  
And whatever he does shall prosper.



## REVELATION 12:15 (NKJV)

**<sup>15</sup>So the serpent spewed water out of his mouth like a flood after the woman, that he might cause her to be carried away by the flood.**



BETTER ROOTS MUST BE:  
FERTILIZED



LUKE 13:6-9 (NKJV)

**‘He also spoke this parable: “A certain man had a fig tree planted in his vineyard, and he came seeking fruit on it and found none. <sup>7</sup>Then he said to the keeper of his vineyard, ‘Look, for three years I have come seeking fruit on this fig tree and find none. Cut it down; why does it use up the ground?’ <sup>8</sup>But he answered and said to him, ‘Sir, let it alone this year also, until I dig around it and fertilize it. <sup>9</sup>And if it bears fruit, well. But if not, after that you can cut it down.’ ”**



ROMANS 12:21 (NKJV)

**<sup>21</sup>Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.**



## PHILIPPIANS 1:9-11 (NKJV)

<sup>9</sup>And this I pray, that your love may abound still more and more in knowledge and all discernment, <sup>10</sup>that you may approve the things that are excellent, that you may be sincere and without offense till the day of Christ, <sup>11</sup>being filled with the fruits of righteousness which are by Jesus Christ, to the glory and praise of God.
