# PSALMS 139:7 (NKJV)

Where can I go from Your Spirit?
Or where can I flee from Your presence?

#### JOHN 14:16-18 (NKJV)

BAnd I will pray the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may abide with you forever- "the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for He dwells with you and will be in you. 18 I will not leave you orphans; I will come to you.

#### JAMES 4:8 (NKJV)

Draw near to God and He will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners; and purify your hearts, you double-minded.

#### GENESIS 3:8 (NKJV)

\*And they heard the sound of the Lord God walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the Lord God among the trees of the garden.

# EXODUS 33:14-16 (NKJV)

<sup>14</sup>And He said, "My Presence will go with you, and I will give you rest." 15 Then he said to Him, "If Your Presence does not go with us, do not bring us up from here. For how then will it be known that Your people and I have found grace in Your sight, except You go with us? So we shall be separate, Your people and I, from all the people who are upon the face of the earth."

#### GENESIS 4:16 (NKJV)

<sup>16</sup>Then Cain went out from the presence of the Lord and dwelt in the land of Nod on the east of Eden.

#### JONAH 1:1-3 (NKJV)

Now the word of the Lord came to Jonah the son of Amittai, saying, "Arise, go to Nineveh, that great city, and cry out against it; for their wickedness has come up before Me." But Jonah arose to flee to Tarshish from the presence of the Lord. He went down to Joppa, and found a ship going to Tarshish; so he paid the fare, and went down into it, to go with them to Tarshish from the presence of the Lord.

# PSALMS 95:1-2 (NKJV)

Oh come, let us sing to the Lord!

Let us shout joyfully to the Rock of our salvation.

<sup>2</sup>Let us come before His presence with thanksgiving;

Let us shout joyfully to Him with psalms.

#### PSALMS 100:1-2 (NKJV)

<sup>1</sup>Make a joyful shout to the Lord, all you lands!
<sup>2</sup>Serve the Lord with gladness;
Come before His presence with singing.

# PSALMS 100:3-4 (NKJV)

<sup>3</sup>Know that the Lord, He is God; It is He who has made us, and not we ourselves;

We are His people and the sheep of His pasture.

Enter into His gates with thanksgiving, And into His courts with praise. Be thankful to Him, and bless His name.
