

#### **GENESIS 2:18 (NKJV)**

<sup>18</sup>And the Lord God said, "It is not good that man should be alone; I will make him a helper comparable to him."



## **JOHN 14:8-9 (NKJV)**

<sup>8</sup>Philip said to Him, "Lord, show us the Father, and it is sufficient for us."

<sup>9</sup>Jesus said to him, "Have I been with you so long, and yet you have not known Me, Philip? He who has seen <u>Me</u> has seen the Father; so how can you say, 'Show us the Father'?



## MATTHEW 5:14-16 (NKJV)

<sup>14</sup>"You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden. <sup>15</sup>Nor do they light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lampstand, and it gives light to all who are in the house. <sup>16</sup>Let <u>your</u> light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.



#### JAMES 3:11-12 (NKJV)

<sup>11</sup>Does a spring send forth fresh water and bitter from the same opening? <sup>12</sup>Can a fig tree, my brethren, bear olives, or a grapevine bear figs? Thus no spring yields both salt water and fresh.



## MATTHEW 7:17-18; 20 (NLT)

<sup>17</sup>A good tree produces good <u>fruit</u>, and a bad tree produces bad fruit. <sup>18</sup>A good tree can't produce bad fruit, and a bad tree can't produce good fruit.

## **ROMANS 5:8 (NKJV)**
