## *Numbers 11:24-25*

<sup>24</sup>So Moses went out and told the people the words of the LORD, and he gathered the seventy men of the elders of the people and placed them around the tabernacle. <sup>25</sup>Then the LORD came down in the cloud, and spoke to him, and took of the Spirit that was upon him, and placed the same upon the seventy elders; and it happened, when the Spirit rested upon them, that they prophesied, although they never did so again.



## *Numbers 11:26-30*



<sup>26</sup>But two men had remained in the camp: the name of one was Eldad, and the name of the other Medad. And the Spirit rested upon them. Now they were among those listed, but who had not gone out to the tabernacle; yet they prophesied in the camp. <sup>27</sup>And a young man ran and told Moses, and said, "Eldad and Medad are prophesying in the camp."



## Numbers 11:26-30



<sup>28</sup>So Joshua the son of Nun, Moses' assistant, one of his choice men, answered and said, "Moses my lord, forbid them!" <sup>29</sup>Then Moses said to him, "Are you zealous for my sake? Oh, that all the LORD's people were prophets and that the LORD would put His Spirit upon them!" <sup>30</sup>And Moses returned to the camp, he and the elders of Israel.

# *1 Corinthians 14:1-3*




<sup>1</sup>Pursue love, and desire spiritual gifts, but especially that you may prophesy. <sup>2</sup>For he who speaks in a tongue does not speak to men but to God, for no one understands him; however, in the spirit he speaks mysteries. <sup>3</sup>But he who prophesies speaks edification and exhortation and comfort to men.



<sup>36</sup>And Joses, who was also named Barnabas by the apostles (which is translated Son of Encouragement), a Levite of the country of Cyprus,



Acts 15:32 

<sup>32</sup> Now Judas and Silas, themselves being prophets also, exhorted and strengthened the brethren with many words.
