## MATTHEW 21:21-22

**<sup>21</sup>So Jesus answered and said to them, “Assuredly, I say to you, if you have faith and do not doubt, you will not only do what was done to the fig tree, but also if you say to this mountain, ‘Be removed and be cast into the sea,’ it will be done. <sup>22</sup>And whatever things you ask in prayer, believing, you will receive.”**

## MARK 11:23-24

**<sup>23</sup>For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says. <sup>24</sup>Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you will have them.**

## ROMANS 10:8-10

**<sup>8</sup>But what does it say? “The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart” (that is, the word of faith which we preach): <sup>9</sup>that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. <sup>10</sup>For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.**

## I PETER 3:4

<sup>4</sup>rather let it be the hidden person of the heart, with the incorruptible beauty of a gentle and quiet spirit, which is very precious in the sight of God.

## ROMANS 2:25-29

**<sup>25</sup>For circumcision is indeed profitable if you keep the law; but if you are a breaker of the law, your circumcision has become uncircumcision.**

**<sup>26</sup>Therefore, if an uncircumcised man keeps the righteous requirements of the law, will not his uncircumcision be counted as circumcision?**



## ROMANS 2:25-29

**<sup>27</sup>And will not the physically uncircumcised, if he fulfills the law, judge you who, even with your written code and circumcision, are a transgressor of the law? <sup>28</sup>For he is not a Jew who is one outwardly, nor is circumcision that which is outward in the flesh;**

## ROMANS 2:25-29

**<sup>29</sup>but he is a Jew who is one inwardly; and circumcision is that of the heart, in the Spirit, not in the letter; whose praise is not from men but from God.**

## **GALATIANS 3:6-9**

**<sup>6</sup>just as Abraham “believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness.” <sup>7</sup>Therefore know that only those who are of faith are sons of Abraham. <sup>8</sup>And the Scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, preached the gospel to Abraham beforehand, saying, “In you all the nations shall be blessed.” <sup>9</sup>So then those who are of faith are blessed with believing Abraham.**
